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Search for Higgs Bosons in $WW^{(*)} \to l^+ l'^-$ Decays BJOERN PENNING, University of Freiburg, D0 COLLABORATION — The process $H \to WW^{(*)} \to l^+ l'^-$ ($l,l'=e,\mu$) is studied in $p\bar{p}$ collisions at the center of mass energy \sqrt{s} =1.96 TeV with the D0 detector at Fermilab. A Higgs particle with a mass greater than 140 GeV primarily decays into a pair of W-bosons and the semi-leptonic decay channels of the W provide a clear signature. The analysed data correspond to 2 fb⁻¹ of integrated luminosity.

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
