Science for the People: The dual nature of Science RODOLFO OSTILLA MONICO, Science for the People, SCIENCE FOR THE PEOPLE COL-LABORATION — Science for the People is an organization dedicated to building a social movement around progressive and radical perspectives on science and society. Because of this, our members are committed to educating scientists and university students about the role that science and technology play in shaping the world, and using our knowledge to work with specific grassroots campaigns.
