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Charged black hole horizons and QED effects JOHNATHON THOMPSON, UC Merced — It is well known that the presence of quantum fields alters many of the classical properties of black holes. In this presentation we consider the lowest-order QED corrections to the location of the event horizons of charged black holes. We conjecture that QED effects protect realistic charged black holes from the phenomenon of mass inflation.
