The Schrdinger Sessions: Science for Science Fiction¹ CHAD ORZEL, Union College Dept. of Physics and Astronomy, EMILY EDWARDS, STEVEN ROLSTON, Joint Quantum Institute — In July 2015, we held a workshop for 17 science fiction writers working in a variety of media at the Joint Quantum Institute at the University of Maryland, College Park. "The Schrdinger Sessions," funded by an outreach grant from APS, provided a three-day "crash course" on quantum physics and technology, including lectures from JQI scientists and tours of JQI labs. The goal was to better inform and inspire stories making use of quantum physics, as a means of outreach to inspire a broad audience of future scientists. We will report on the contents of the workshop, reactions from the attendees and presenters, and future plans.
