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The Bernoulli or Coanda Conundrum and Other Classical Demonstration Myths DALE STILLE<sup>1</sup>, IAAPT — Lecture Demonstration professionals have recently taken a closer look at demonstrations that were traditionally labeled "Bernoulli Demonstrations" in most textbooks. This examination has shown that in most cases the Coanda Effect, Magnus Effect, and Entrainment may be better explanations for most of these classic demonstrations. A discussion of other similarly classic demonstrations and some of their problems or misconceptions will also be presented.

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
