The National Science Foundations (NSF) funds many Research Experience for Undergraduate Students (REU) Programs at many Universities in the US. The NSF also funds a small number of REU programs which allow students to conduct their summer research abroad. One of these programs is the International REU for Gravitation which is organized out of the University of Florida.
