Research activities using High Intensity Gamma-ray Source facility at ${\rm TUNL^1}$ KRISHICHAYAN ., ${\rm TUNL/Duke~University}$

Current ongoing research activities using the High Intensity Gamma-ray source (HI γ S) facility at TUNL will be presented. Experimental setup, analysis, and results will be focused on the following low-energy activities: (1) Mono-energetic photon induced 235 U/ 239 Pu fission cross-section ratio measurements at $E_{\gamma}=8$ - 13 MeV, (2) Mono-energetic photon induced Fission-Product-Yield measurements on 235 U, and 239 Pu at $E_{\gamma}=11.0$ and 13.0 MeV, and (3) Systematic study of Pygmy Dipole Resonances in nuclei across the nuclear landscape.

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
