Perspectives from the Inside and Outside - Advocating for Science and Science Policy

As with any form of communication, advocacy for science and science policy requires identifying key audiences and opportunities. In this presentation, some of the main opportunities for advocacy with the Executive and Legislative Branches are identified and illustrated. As a preface and because of the tight coupling with advocacy opportunities, the Federal budget cycle is briefly reviewed.
